

RESOLUTION NO. R 49 -2009

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE FAYETTE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR CONTINUATION OF THE CITY-COUNTY DOG WARDEN SERVICES CONTRACT.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager of the City of Washington Court House be, and hereby is, authorized to enter into an agreement titled City-County Dog Warden Services Contract, dated January 1, 2010 with the Fayette County Commissioners for the continuation of Dog Warden services within the City of Washington. The agreement shall cover the period beginning January 1, 2010 and continue to December 31, 2010.

**SECTION 2.** That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

## CITY-COUNTY DOG WARDEN SERVICES CONTRACT

This is an agreement entered into between the Commissioners of Fayette County, Ohio hereinafter referred to as "Commissioners", and the City of Washington Court House, hereinafter referred to as the "City".

WHEREAS, the City has enacted legislation to control and curb the stray dogs and domestic animals wandering at large within the City of Washington C.H., and;

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it does not have adequate personnel and equipment to enforce such legislation and is desirous of implementing the same, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have the necessary equipment and personnel to assist the City, now, therefore,

In consideration of the following mutual promises and undertakings, the Commissioners and the City agree as follows:

1. Commissioners agree with the City to furnish one (1) dog warden whose primary responsibility is within the City, specially equipped small truck used for enforcement, other related equipment, a second dog warden who will help in the City as needed, and use of the dog pound to implement and enforce the City's dog ordinance.

2. Such enforcement to be solely within the City limits of the City of Washington Court House.

3. In consideration of the furnishing of such personnel services and equipment by the Commissioners, the City agrees and shall pay the Commissioners the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$20,000.00) for the period of Twelve (12) months from January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010, the method and mode of payment shall be determined by mutual agreement between the City and the Commissioners.

4. The dog warden shall submit a monthly activity report to the City Council Service Committee in person, and act as a liaison on other animal control issues providing referral services, but not enforcement.


It is further understood that all calls concerning dog complaints inside the City of Washington Court House will be handled through the City Police Department.

Each party has read this document and this agreement constitutes their complete and full understanding of the same.

This Contract shall commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2010 and continue to and include the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 2010.
