

RESOLUTION NO. R20-2010

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE CITY COUNCIL'S SUPPORT OF THE STATE LAW PROHIBITING THE ACT OF TEXTING WHILE DRIVING.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Washington Court House desires to support the enactment of a State Law to prohibit texting while driving; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Washington Court House desires to communicate said Council's support of the prohibition upon texting while driving to the member of the General Assembly of the State of Ohio representing the population of the City of Washington Court House.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Washington Court House supports the concept of a State Law prohibiting texting while driving.

SECTION 2. That Council's Clerk shall provide this Resolution to State Representative Ray Pryor and State Senator John Carey.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
