

RESOLUTION NO. R21-2010

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SUPPORT OF CITY COUNCIL FOR THE MISSION OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE UNITED STATES AIR FORCE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Washington Court House desires to support the mission of the National Museum of the United States Air Force; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Washington Court House recognizes Dayton, Ohio as the home of the Wright Brothers and the birthplace of aviation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Washington Court House acknowledges that in excess of one million visitors per year visit the National Museum of the United States Air Force; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE, FAYETTE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Washington Court House supports the decision to permanently display one of the soon-to-be retired space shuttles at the National Museum of the United States Air force.

SECTION 2. That Council's Clerk shall provide this Resolution to NASA Administrator Charles F. Bolden.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.
