3. The Committee benefited from the review of the E. Elm Street project, Quail Run lift station project, and the Leesburg Avenue project. The Committee recommended that legislation be brought to Council to apply for the Issue 1 grant.
4. The Committee noted that wood chipping would begin on August 23<sup>rd</sup> through October on a one call per household basis.
5. The Committee discussed an idea of a proclamation to recognize citizens who put forth effort on beautifying their homes within the City. The Committee recommended that this be brought to the Tree Committee for further discussion.
6. The Committee benefited from an update on pool operations.
